- Only members of the Rotary Club of Forest Grove can nominate.

**Selection Process**

- Nominations must be received by no later than Fri., Mar. 1.
- Nominations must be submitted on this form and cannot exceed 500 words.
- The Club's Community Service Committee will select the recipient (subject to approval by the club's Board of Directors).

The recipient of the Mike Ward Community Service Award will be honored at the club's annual Crab Feed on Wed., Mar. 27. The recipient will receive a \$250 contribution to a charity of their choice.
